- PAINTS: Raw Sienna, Cerulean & French-U-Marine Blues, Lemon Yellow, Burnt Sienna, Alizarin Crimson and Crimson/Scarlet Lake
- Water containers x 2
- Old towel
- Tissues
- Painting board, masking tape, pencil and eraser.

I always like to stretch my paper onto the board, if that's your preference, as I find it's easier to work with.

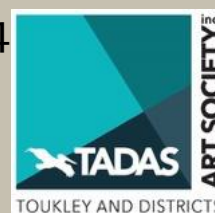

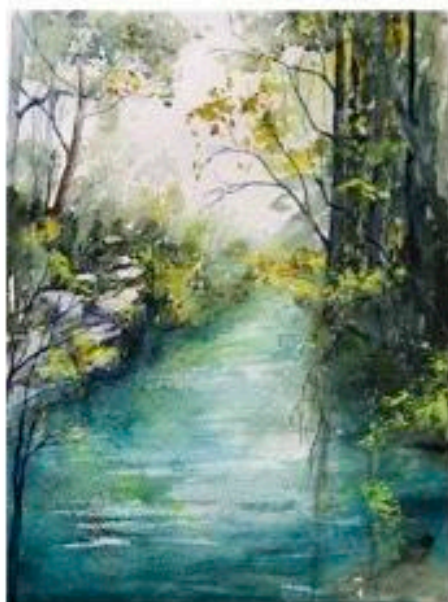
